PowerHealth Solutions' new-generation hospital billing solution **PowerBilling & Revenue Collection** has been selected by a South East Asian Health Authority to replace its in-house developed systems. The Health Authority operates 41 public hospitals, 47 specialist out-patient clinics and 74 general outpatient clinics.

Business drivers for change include increased demand for hospital services as a result of population growth and ageing, the shift from episodic acute conditions to relapsing chronic conditions and age-related illnesses, as well as increasing expectations for improved service quality from a better educated community.

To respond to these challenges and other funding drivers, the Health Authority identified the need for a new patient billing system that could cope with its increasingly complex billing rules, and also provide inbuilt flexibility to accommodate future change.

After an exhaustive and highly competitive tender process, **PowerBilling & Revenue Collection** was identified as the best solution to meet the business need.

Implementation is currently in progress, with go-live scheduled for 2011. The project is part of a large-scale Enterprise Resource Planning project in partnership with **ORACLE**, which includes Human Resources, Payroll and Financial Systems, as well as Patient and Sundry Debtor billing.
